IMPORTANT CHANGES and UPDATES from Annual General Meeting (AGM)

As you know our AGM is an opportunity for active club members to voice their views on club operation. I do need to say that this year attendance of members was on a weaker side.

I really hope that all members recognize the importance of this event. This is also an opportunity for the Executive team to hear from their members what changes they would like to see, what we need to pay attention to, etc.

Even though the attendance was not as expected, it still was a very productive meeting and great discussions occurred.

The first change is affecting the facility improvement fee that has been unanimously approved to be increased by \$10.00 per year, per family. **Therefore effective of Jan.1, 2017 all new members will pay \$50.00 for facility improvement fee.** Current active members will pay this increase in September when re-registering for the new fiscal year – 2017-2018.

The second change will affect every active member of the club. As you know we are a non-profit club trying to keep all costs to minimum. None of this would be possible without the dedication of the very effective board and few other club members. Our goal is to involve everyone.

Therefore at the AGM we had a very fruitful discussion around volunteering. This topic is not new. I have talked about the importance of volunteering in the last issue of our newsletter.

Since we still have mostly the same people giving their time we have introduced mandatory volunteering hours per family. From Sept.1, to June 30 everyone will commit to 20 hours for the club. This can be accomplished through fundraising activities, volunteering at special events, set up for special events, (Black Belts) supporting Master Steve during classes, etc. In order to monitor the commitment we have implemented \$75.00 post-dated check for June 30. Those who will complete the hours, the cheque will be returned. Those who will not meet the hours will be informed by mid June that the cheque will be cashed on the 30th of June.

Please provide postdated cheque to the office no later than January 30. If you do volunteer with the club please keep your records and get one of the executive team member to verify it by their initials.
